Beacon Bonfire is back for another year, and it's still not your average festival. A dynamic expression of Beacon's community and creative minds, this edition of the biannual celebration is set to upstage the sellout crowd of 2023. Beacon Bonfire invites all to Be Curious. To immerse oneself in the festivities, engage with 400+ local artists, and the community. A film festival highlights Beacon Bonfire's brand-new additions, plus installations inspired by Beacon and beyond. Bonfire's lineup will run from Nov. 5-9. The main activation of the festival is Saturday and Sunday. One main festival draw is the Main Street takeover, a vibrant stretch of fun, food, and dancing. This year, the entire mile of Main Street will be packed with art and music, pulsating with positive energy. "We're utilizing the resources of Main Street and the different venues. We're there to promote and support the restaurants, the galleries and all the businesses on Main Street. [Beacon Bonfire] will draw a lot of people into town, and they're going to be there for a few days," said Kelly Ellenwood, co-founder of Beacon Bonfire. Film screenings, trivia, and filmmaker Q&As at Industrial Arts Brewing Company. Ecstatic dance and movement workshops, to name a few. Interfaith Summit addresses innovative steps to prevent crimes

We live in turbulent times. Active threats and crimes of hate are on the rise, and houses of worship, in which many seek solace, are becoming targets. In Dutchess County, Sheriff Kirk Imperati, District Attorney Anthony Parisi, and members of local police departments held an Interfaith Summit on Oct. 28 at the MJN Convention Center in Poughkeepsie with a program entitled "Learn F.A.I.T.H.: Facing Active Incident Threats in Houses of Worship." "If you read our Declaration of Independence, and you read the Constitution of the United States, our founding fathers were so forward thinking, they could stand the test of time. Our country was based upon debate, our country was based upon freedom of religion, our country was based on freedom of speech, on free enterprise," said Sheriff Imperati, who led the organization of the event. "Who would've thought we would need to be here today to have this summit?" Sadly, attacks on houses of worship have become increasingly frequent. According to the Faith-Based Information and Analysis Organization, 841 attacks on

houses of worship were reported in 2024 on the national level. According to the data, New York had the second-highest number of attacks, with 64. Attacks on houses of worship aren't new, though. They've occurred for decades. We've even had them in Dutchess County. "On Pentecost Sunday in May of 2008, our church was

burned to the ground," said Rev. Dr. Edward L. Hunt of Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in Wappingers Falls. "We never found out who did it. What we do know is that safety is everyone's business. When something happens in one place, it's an indication it can happen somewhere else."

Dedication of U.S. flag retirement receptacle set for Veterans Day in Fishkill

There will be a special dedication of a U.S. flag retirement receptacle. The dedication ceremony will be held on Veterans Day, Nov. 11, at noon. The box is sponsored by McHoul Funeral Home in Fishkill and sponsored by the Rotary Club of Fishkill. The ceremony will take place at McHoul Funeral Home, 1089 Main St. in the village, at noon. Rotarians Eddie Colon and Melinda Potter recently spoke about the project. "Eddie went to drop flags off at another location and found the flags not being honored. He was very upset and expressed his discontent," recalled Potter. Potter said Colon, whose son served in the military, has been talking about doing this project for a while. Local business owner Carmine Istvan, who is also the Town of Fishkill Highway Superintendent, will use his company to lay the foundation for the project. Julie Spann, who is the executive director of Blodgett Memorial Library, is also assisting with the ceremony, where the National Anthem and "Taps" will be played.

Serino outlines proposals in 2026 Executive Budget

Dutchess County Executive Sue Serino outlined her 2026 Executive Budget proposal last week to County legislators, elected officials and community stakeholders at the County Legislature Chambers in Poughkeepsie. Her proposed plan for 2026 emphasizes strategic investments in public safety, housing, youth initiatives, and services for seniors, veterans and families while staying below the New York State property tax cap.

Serino said, “This budget is all about protecting people with purpose – recognizing that every decision we make, every dollar we spend must be done in a way that protects our taxpayers while also protecting the programs and services our neighbors depend on. We’ve worked hard to make sure every dollar is spent wisely, with investments in public safety, mental health, seniors, and youth, while making sure we are prepared for future uncertainty.”

The proposed 2026 Executive Budget totals \$651.4 million with 1.8% increase in total spending compared to the modified 2025 budget, with no reduction in services and no employee layoffs. State and federal mandates continue to dominate the annual spending plan, consuming more than 70% of the budget and adding \$6.7 million in new spending for the year.

Under the plan, the 2026 property tax levy will be \$106 million, below the New York State property tax cap, and the property tax rate will drop 3% from \$2.17 to \$2.10 per \$1,000 of assessed value. If approved, this will be the 11th consecutive year property owners will see a reduction in the County tax rate.

Sales tax revenues are projected at \$273.8 million, funding 42% of the 2026 Budget. The County’s sales tax rate will remain at 3.75%, one of only six counties

with a sales tax rate below 4% in New York State. The budget will see elimination of the local sales tax exemption on clothing and footwear items under \$110 effective March 1st, generating an additional \$5.4 million in revenue to support critical programs and services. Local municipalities will also benefit from the additional revenue as the County shares its sales tax with cities, towns and villages.

The Community Benefit Fund, established by County Executive Serino last year, will fund \$3.2 million in critical initiatives, offsetting taxes.

The 2026 Executive Budget uses \$23.5 million from the County’s general fund balance to minimize impact on taxpayers, while maintaining a reliable fund balance reserve for any future uncertainty.

Dutchess County’s longstanding commitment to conservative fiscal management is evidenced by its AA+ credit rating from Standard & Poor’s. The County’s fiscal stability was also confirmed recently with a perfect score of “0” on the New York State Comptroller’s Fiscal Stress Report, the best rating achievable.

Legislator Stephen Caswell, Chair of the Budget, Finance and Personnel Committee said, “I appreciate County Executive Serino’s overview today of the 2026 Executive Budget and her focus on maintaining our County’s fiscal stability while serving the needs of the community. Together with my legislative colleagues, I look forward to reviewing the plan, as well as delving into it deeper in the coming weeks with the support of the Budget Office, to adopt a final budget that serves our residents in the most cost-efficient way possible”

Democratic response to budget presentation: Families can’t afford Serino’s tax increase

County Executive Sue Serino announced a tax increase on clothing and footwear as part of her budget presentation on Oct. 29. Clothing and footwear are currently exempt from the county's 4% sales tax. Serino’s budget includes a plan to eliminate this exemption in the first quarter of next year.

“The Republican-led county government’s mismanagement of funds - including a luxury clubhouse at the baseball stadium, mind-boggling pay raises, and failed litigation against New York State -

has necessitated this tax increase,” said Minority Leader, Yvette Valdés Smith. “This rash decision will disproportionately hurt working families in Dutchess County, and Democratic legislators will challenge it.”

Valdes-Smith added that the budget also fails to properly address the EMS crisis, where large portions of the county continue to endure slow ambulance response times, endangering lives. It also contains no meaningful funds for our efforts to deal with the housing crisis.

Chief Lucchesi prevents potentially catastrophic collision

Calls 911, pursues wrong-way vehicle on I-84

At approximately 8:15 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 31, City of Beacon Fire Chief Thomas Lucchesi intervened to prevent a potentially catastrophic collision after encountering a wrong-way driver traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of Interstate 84 near Lime Kiln Road in the Town of East Fishkill.

Chief Lucchesi was returning from Hopewell Fire Equipment after picking up a department vehicle when he observed a sedan traveling directly toward oncoming traffic. Multiple vehicles, including several tractor-trailers, were forced to take evasive action to avoid a collision.

“It’s not often that my heart drops and my adrenaline spikes outside of a fire scene,” Chief Lucchesi said. “As I rounded a curve, I suddenly saw a car coming straight at me. Vehicles were swerving everywhere to avoid her.”

Recognizing the imminent danger, Chief Lucchesi activated his emergency lights and siren, turned around, and pursued the wrong-way vehicle to get it stopped safely. After catching up, he was able to position his vehicle ahead of the driver and bring her to a stop without incident near the Lime Kiln Road area.

Upon approaching the vehicle, the driver—an elderly woman—appeared disoriented and stated she had made a wrong turn. Chief Lucchesi immediately contacted Dutchess County 911, who confirmed they had already received multiple

calls reporting the wrong-way driver. New York State Police units arrived several minutes later and took over the scene.

“It’s a reminder of how quickly things can go wrong on the road,” Lucchesi added. “Thankfully, no one was injured, and the situation was resolved safely.”

The incident caused brief traffic disruptions on westbound I-84 but was cleared quickly once the driver and vehicle were safely removed from the roadway.

Mayor Lee Kyriacou publicly thanked Chief Lucchesi noting, “The Chief’s quick thinking and courageous action likely saved one or more lives today (Oct. 31), and the City of Beacon is fortunate to have a Fire Chief who always goes above and beyond to help others. Job well, done, Chief Lucchesi.”

Attacks have indeed occurred elsewhere, and they indirectly led to this summit. In May 2022, an individual opened fire at a grocery store in Buffalo. In response, Gov. Kathy Hochul mandated that every county in N.Y. have a safety plan in place by Dec. 2022.

The Dutchess County Threat Assessment Group, or DTAG, headlines the safety plan in Dutchess County. DTAG focuses on early intervention without requiring action by law enforcement. They seek to help people who are on the path to committing a crime. DTAG is made aware of individuals of concern through a nomination process. Once the individual is selected for further assistance, DTAG assesses their current level in the six steps of the pathway to violence. The six steps are: grievance – the belief that the individual has been wronged or treated unfairly. Ideation – The individual falls into a belief system that glamorizes violence or moral outrage. Research and planning – the individual begins to research places and people to attack, for example through social media and Internet searches Preparation – The individual starts to acquire the necessary items for their attack. Breach – the individual attempts to gain entry or follow their target. Attack – the individual carries out the attack.

DTAG tries to help individuals at the first two to three levels. “We’re trying

to redirect these people back,” said Sheriff's Office Detective Sergeant James Daniels. “These are people that have something going on in life, and we try to get them resources ... they’re thinking of doing something wrong, but they’re still reachable.” DTAG then works to help these people and provides resources where appropriate. Aid can be provided in various forms, such as mental healthcare, assistance with housing and other social services.

If an individual progresses past the first two to three levels of the pathway to violence, it's time for the police and the county district attorney to step in. In the past few years alone, they've rapidly improved their ability to monitor and respond to hate crimes.

“When I first took office, I did a complete evaluation of the operation of the D.A.’s office,” said Parisi. “One of the gaps that was identified related to hate crimes.”

Before Parisi taking over, there was no hate crimes unit or prosecutor in Dutchess County. His office applied for and received a \$1 million grant from the federal government to establish a hate crimes unit. “If we can prevent even a single person from being a victim, we’re successful,” said Parisi. “This unit isn’t just about prosecution. It’s about stopping hate and preventing incidents.” Prevention starts with state-of-the-art technology purchased with the grant. “ShadowDragon” is one such tool.

“ShadowDragon” is an open-source

intelligence (OSINT) tool designed for social media monitoring and analysis. It provides the ability to constantly scan a variety of social media platforms and forums, searching for anything that may indicate a crime is being planned or has been committed. The D.A.’s office has also established a CrimeWatch page to crowdsource data, to maintain transparency and keep the community informed. The CrimeWatch page features a map showing reported crimes, resources on various types of crimes, and a link to their Flock page. Flock is a community policing site where private citizens can register or integrate their cameras to make it easier for law enforcement to gather data on a crime. Registering your camera informs law enforcement that you have a camera at a specific location and may be able to provide footage if requested. Integrating your camera allows law enforcement to stream footage directly from your camera if needed. The D.A.’s office utilizes this data as part of A.R.C.T.I.C., the Analysis and Real-Time Crime Intelligence Center. If a crime is committed and it appears to be a hate crime, the Hate Crimes Unit takes over.

“I work with people in my unit to root out evil and prosecute individuals who are committing these crimes in the county,” said hate crime unit supervisor Michael Liviano. “New York State has developed a portion of the penal code related to hate crimes to make it possible to seek enhanced sentencing status

for individuals who are properly convicted of a hate crime.”

To qualify as a hate crime, the target must be selected due to a protected characteristics such as race, sex, gender or religion. Examples of crimes that may qualify include damage to a house of worship due to the denomination, and swastikas or other hate symbols being spray-painted on a building. The best offense is often a good defense, and protecting a house of worship from hate crimes is no different. “Trouble doesn’t have a denomination,” said Rev. Hunt. “We can all be victimized, and it can really destroy lives.”

During the summit, one of the focuses was on keeping your house of worship safe. The sheriff’s office has established a program to assist houses of worship in need of support. They will visit houses of worship and conduct a site assessment.

“As we go through, we like to discuss best practices and ensure you understand some of the options you have because the best security features don’t always go with the openness of a house of worship,” said Sheriff’s Deputy Michael DeRosa. During a site assessment, they give recommendations, such as increased lighting to deter criminals who don’t want to be seen, or what doors should be locked to prevent unauthorized visitors from roaming unaccompanied.

Individuals associated with houses of worship who wish to have a site visit should contact the Sheriff’s office.

Previously known as the Popular Annual Financial Report, the People’s Annual Financial Report provides a summary of the year ended 2024 audited financial statements for the County, as well as key demographic data. The report continues to provide readers with digestible information unique to Dutchess County in the hopes of keeping residents both engaged and informed.

“This report does more than share details of Dutchess County’s financial performance in 2024,” said Comptroller Aymar-Blair. “It’s a broader profile of the County: Who we are, where we live and work, our history, economy and government.”

As to why the name of the report has been revised, the Comptroller continued, “We are renaming this annual report to reflect that this information belongs to the people. All of the information that the Comptroller’s Office

touches is a public good, meaning it belongs to you.”

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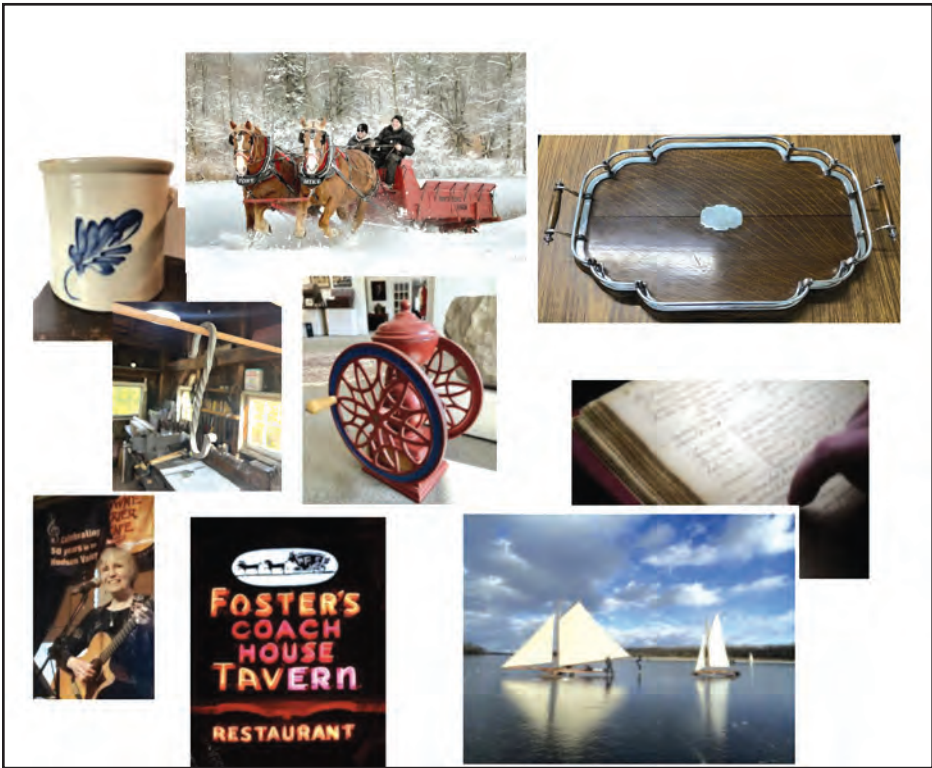
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DCHS Auction ends with live event Nov. 9

One will then be able to place destroyed or ripped flags in a place of honor. According to organizers, the flag box is being dedicated to all our heroes, of past, present, and future.

Doug McHoul, who is in the Dutchess County Legislature, owns McHoul Funeral Home with his extended family. The business also has an East Fishkill location.

“It’s an honor for us to help the Rotary Club by facilitating this project. Our location on Main Street is the perfect site for the flag retirement receptacle, so I hope that it will quickly catch the attention of local residents. Those individuals who use the receptacle will have the opportunity to dedicate their flag in memory or honor of someone,” McHoul said in an email to Beacon Free Press.

McHoul explained, “Our plan for now is to store the received flags at the funeral home until Flag Day, when the Rotary Club plans on hosting a flag disposition

ceremony. That event is currently a work in progress, but details will be made available to the public as we get closer to June.”

“The whole things about it, why in this community should I go to another village or town to drop off my flags?” asked Colon. Colon added, “The veterans do not get the credit that they deserve. Every day, when they drive by and see the box, they will say ‘They still care.’”

Potter remarked, “I have always been a huge supporter of the flag. Knowing that our flag is going to be honored, for the veterans, and what their service means to us, knowing we created this for our veterans and our nation...the flag means so much.”

Colon said their “job” and responsibility” then will be to maintain the box and flags. Anyone who drops a flag off can also take a card to dedicate the flag to honor someone in their life, noted Potter.

“I’d like to ask the veterans [and the community] please come and join us. At the end of the day, it’s not for me, it’s not for the Rotary, it’s for them,” said Colon.

The festival is car-free. Beacon Bonfire is designed to be walkable, bikeable, and suitable for public transportation, including the Beacon Free Loop. Visitors are also encouraged to park at the Metro-North Train Station in Beacon.

At the campus of the former Beacon High School, on Route 52, indoor fun for the masses at KuBe Art Center. Creative Director Donna Mikkelsen and company have worked endlessly to promote Bonfire Beacon’s most extensive indoor free-of-cost festivities.

This year marks the introduction of “Seat at the Table”, inviting all people to Eliza Street to a “third place” for gathering, without financial exchanges or contracts. Mikkelsen brings a table 50 feet long and enveloped in live grass, with room for laughter, creativity, and play.

“Seat at the Table is a place for families, kids, for people to come and play and interact with art and artists. It is for all ages, and we will be drawing, playing games, and we have artist Elizabeth Castagna coming in,” said Mikkelsen, who leads Beacon Bonfire’s visual arts programming.

Castagna will be leading a workshop in segni mossi, an art style from Italy

that combines body movement with visual art. It will push the boundaries of creativity, combining two modes of expression often seen as detached from one another. The backdrop of this installation is a 50-foot-long, grass-enveloped table, inviting neighbors, friends, and families to join in on creative interaction. Seat at the Table will be active on Saturday from Noon - 7 p.m. and Sunday from Noon - 3 p.m.

On the closing day of Beacon Bonfire, Mikkelsen will also be holding a collaborative symmetry workshop.

The volunteer-run organization had a year of rest, reflection, and renewal in putting on the latest rendition of the biennial (every other year) festival. The BonfireWORKS Foundation, a nonprofit dedicated to fostering creativity and connection, was able to help fund artists’ pay, among other operational costs. Grants, donations, and partnerships helped to offset other expenses.

Through the Pink Unicorn Fund, ticket-buyers can make a “buy one, give one” purchase to fund the attendance of a community member who may not otherwise afford it.

Be curious. Be creative. Be at Beacon Bonfire. Roast a s’more, and engage with community arts.

Ex-Renegades managers Albernaz, Butera to lead MLB teams in 2026

The Los Angeles Dodgers are again world champions. The MLB season is freshly over, and it's bye-bye baseball until February. By then, eight of the 30 dugouts will be led by new voices, maybe more. The Hudson Valley knows two of them well. As announced in late October, former Renegades managers Blake Butera and Craig Albernaz will take their talents to the Big Show.

Both are replacing managers fired in mid-season. Baltimore booted Brandon Hyde six weeks into 2025, as the O's saw a 15-28 start. Davey Martinez was fired in Washington in mid-July heat.

Butera and Albernaz crossed paths in the Hudson Valley. Butera was rising through the Tampa Bay Rays' organization, while Albernaz was in his third year coaching. The Renegades would win it all in 2017. Albernaz was the manager. Butera, the Renegades' first base line brigadier, was first in line to replace him the following season. He became the youngest manager in Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.

Butera is the youngest MLB manager since 1972, when the Minnesota Twins hired Frank Quilici. Quilici was also 33, and his five minutes of managerial fame were soured by Minnesota's less-than-savory season.

The New York Yankees employed five players older than Butera, who is the same age as Aaron Judge.

Albernaz was a close second in the

Cleveland Guardians' great managerial race of 2023, a contest that ultimately fell in favor of Stephen Vogt ("Remember that

Renegade?"), Albernaz joined his fellow Renegade alumni for Vogt's historic first-year Coach of the Year run in 2024.

It started orange for Albernaz, who became the San Francisco Giants' bullpen and catching coach in 2019. This Baltimore gig is his first MLB managerial position.

Together, Butera and Albernaz bring extensive experience from the Rays organization.

Butera, twice Manager of the Year in MiLB, was the Rays' assistant field coordinator in 2023 and senior director of player development in 2024.

While Butera has no managerial experience on any level, he isn't the only one that MLB teams have taken a risk on. NCAA champion coach Tony Vitello has left his Tennessee roots for a different baseball giant, one of the San Francisco variety.

With the High-A Bowling Green Hot Rods, Albernaz was the Midwest League Manager of the Year in 2018. In Cleveland, with fellow Renegades' alum Vogt, Albernaz was the bench coach, then associate manager.

The Nationals have missed six postseasons in a row. The Orioles disappointed this season, dead last in the American League East after a 91-win season in 2024. Both franchises are rife with young talent that could benefit from the experience of these first-year managers. As Hudson Valley roots for former players in the MLB, they'll be just as happy for the fourth and fifth Renegades alumni in history to earn the title of MLB skipper.

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History of the Lenape and Mount Gulian Historic Site Nov. 15

Learn about local history by attending a talk the Lenape Native Americans, the first inhabitants of the region, at Mount Gulian Historic Site on Saturday, Nov. 15 at 1 p.m. in Beacon. Local tribes such as the Wappinger, Esopus and Tappan encountered Henry Hudson along the Mahicannituck in 1609, changing things dramatically forever, according to organizers.

Mount Gulian’s property, which was owned by the Verplanck family, was identified as the site of temporary Lenape encampments, and was also the site of the Rombout Patent of 1683, the Indian deed selling much of Dutchess County to colonial settlers, it was noted.

“The Verplancks had many interactions with the Lenape, starting from the Verplancks’ arrival in New Amsterdam circa 1634. In 1683, Gulian Verplanck and partners bought 85,000 acres of land from the local Wappinger Indians (Lenape) under the Rombout Patent, for approximately \$1,200 worth of trade goods, forcing the migration of Lenape People from most of Dutchess County,” said Mount Gulian Executive Director Elaine Hayes.

So, who are the Lenape people?

“The Lenape are a large indigenous cultural group whose Lenapehoking territory stretched from the southern Catskills throughout the Hudson Valley, through New Jersey and into Maryland and Delaware, western Pennsylvania and into central Long Island. Before the colonial period, Lenape lived in hundreds of settlements throughout Lenapehoking and were honored as the “Grandfather People” by other nearby Tribes for their long history here, their prowess at warfare, as well as their negotiation and mediation skills.

Lenape fished, hunted and gathered nature’s bounty here for centuries and were a farming people, with every settlement having rich gardens. They were a matriarchal society, with most leadership, family and big decisions made by women,” explained Harv Hilowitz, who will be giving the talk at Mount Gulian.

Hilowitz, a contributing scholar for the Maritime Museum in Kingston, said “All Americans need to know about the Lenape, their lifeways in the pre-colonial period, their siding with the Americans during the Revolution, their forced migrations into Wisconsin, Oklahoma and Ontario, their survival strategies in the face of erasure, and the fact that they are thriving to this day with over 20,000 people self-identifying as Lenape, some in the Hudson Valley. Mount Gulian is a part of that story and is proud to tell others about it.”

Hayes stated, “We hope visitors will leave the talk knowing that the Lenape are a federally recognized sovereign Tribal Nation, directly involved in the renaissance of Indian Country in this area. Lenape are reviving their language and material and cultural practices, even growing their unique varieties of corn here again. Lenape want their stolen sacred objects repatriated to their People, and to be part of the conversation as to how their history is told and their culture interpreted by non-Native institutions. Most importantly, visitors will learn about a local People’s survival in the face of great adversity, an important lesson in today’s world.”

Admission to the talk is \$18/adults; \$15/seniors; \$12/children (5-15 years). Walk-ins are welcome, if spots are available. Mount Gulian members’ admission to the talk is free. One may sign up for mem-

The Food Bank

Going behind the scenes at the Regional Food Bank Hudson Valley



As I'm writing this, on Sunday, November 2, the federal government is still shut down, leaving the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) in limbo. I visited the Regional Food Bank Hudson Valley last Thursday, where the Food Bank's executive vice president Felicia Kalan told me that if the SNAP impasse is not resolved, "we will be in a state of emergency."

The Regional Food Bank Hudson Valley serves 23 counties in Eastern New York, working to alleviate hunger and prevent food waste by accepting large donations of food from the food industry and distributing those donations to more than 1,000 programs and partners that feed our neighbors in need. 54 million pounds went out last year, but they can't possibly move the estimated 36 million pounds of food that will be needed just in November if SNAP is not restored. That's because the loss of the average \$187 monthly benefit will drive 40 million nationwide participants to local food pantries like Dutchess Outreach Lunch Box or Town of Clinton Food Pantry.

The Regional Food Bank Hudson Valley operates out of a brand-new 50,000-square-foot warehouse in Montgomery, where food is collected, stored and distributed. Matt Wynkoop, manager of food industry partnerships, took me on a tour. At the loading dock, 17 pallets of Count Chocula breakfast cereal had just been delivered, maybe a donation from Target. I asked Matt if the Food Bank ever refuses a donation, if it's too much of something. Well, maybe a trailer load of gummy bears, which they once re-donated to other regional food banks. But for now, every kid in the Hudson

Valley will be wolfing down Count Chocula cereal.

We toured the giant coolers, and the deep freezer, critical for storing coveted donations of fresh produce, dairy and meat. In one

large room, a team of volunteers was sorting a variety of items, including cherry tomatoes from Hepworth Farms, into individual packets. These boxes are moved to the shipping area, where food pantries come to pick them up. I was surprised to learn that the pantries actually pay for the food, at way below wholesale prices, but they still pay, using money from grants or donations. The Food Bank itself is a 501 (c)(3) not-for-profit organization. The people, corporations, or grocery stores that donate can deduct the value from their gross income.

As the Food Bank's manager of food industry partnerships, Matt Wynkoop works with local farmers to organize donations of excess fruits and vegetables. New York farmers donate about 10 million pounds of food in a typical year. In addition, the state-funded Nourish New York program provides funds for food banks to buy excess products directly from farmers. It costs a lot to harvest fruits and vegetables. To help with these expenses, and to keep good food from rotting in the field, farmers can receive a 25% tax credit, up to \$5,000 total, for donations. Local farms, including Fishkill Farms and Dykeman Farm in Pawling have gone way above and beyond this total.

I was curious about sell by dates. It turns out that Food Banks will accept and distribute food that is past the expiration or sell by date on the label. It depends on the items. (I personally eat lots of food that's past the "best by" date. Some of the items on my spice rack, like whole cloves, for example, are 40 years old!) Placards on the wall at the sorting area guide the volunteers on how to address this issue. Meat and dairy cannot be distributed past the indicated date. Canned goods are okay for a few extra weeks if they're not dented or leaking. The Count Chocula cereal is nowhere near its sell by date, but I guess the store figures nobody will buy it after Halloween.

But would kids still eat it? If SNAP benefits have not been restored by the time you read this, we're about to find out.

The Food Bank Hudson Valley is sponsoring free Thanksgiving dinners for families in need. Matt will be manning the drive-through location, 10 a.m. on November 22 at Dutchess Community College.
