As one drives, or walks, through the village of Wappingers Falls, one might notice the colorful artwork that brightens up some of the local businesses on East and West Main streets. The artist who has painted these artwork pieces is award-winning artist Brian Zickafoose. Zickafoose moved to Wappingers Falls is 2018.

Zickafoose was recently interviewed in front of Abuela Paty Creationes, 2653 E. Main St., where one of his murals is painted on the window.

"This particular piece is one the owner wanted for her dog that passed recently," Zickafoose stated. The rainbow is for the "Rainbow Bridge," which is said to be the journey an animal takes once it dies.

There is a pink heart with wings, with the pet's name, Marshi, painted on it. There are also purple paw prints.

"Brian captured exactly what I was looking for -- this artwork is a memorial for our beloved pet Marshi who passed away recently. Brian is a true artist with a big heart. This work of art means a lot to



my family, especially my kids," said Liliam Patricia Abril, owner of Abuela Paty Creations, via email.

Zickafoose said the murals "are bringing a splash of color" to the area and "draws the eye to the stores."

Corrinne Sternberg is the owner and operator of The Hog, at 2703 W. Main St., in Wappingers Falls.

"The window art trend has truly become a visual representation of the strong sense of community that exists in the Village. We're honored to be a part of it and for the opportunity to support a local artist, who's essentially turning our Village into a drive through art installation. It makes us such a unique little pocket of the county," commented Sternberg.

Asked about the response, she replied,

"the customer response has been very positive, with many people inquiring about the artist. It's definitely a conversation starter. The business response has been amazing, it seems every day Brian has made his mark on another storefront."

Sternberg explained, "In the fall, after taking a look at Brian's past work, we (The Hog) asked him to showcase his personal style, so he gave us some beautiful, colorful designs. When we asked Brian to come back in the winter, we chose a seasonal display, as many other storefronts do."

Brian said he is "working on bringing together several local artists to create and install large murals in the village."

"My hope is to kind of ignite a public renaissance in the Village and bring art to the people."

Phil Cordero is co-owner of Café Con Leche, 2710 West Main St., in Wappingers Falls.

"As a local business who loves supporting other local businesses, we sought out Brian after seeing his work at neighboring businesses. It was also a plus to find out that he was a local artist," said Cordero via email. Regarding the response from Café Con Leche's customers, Cordero said, "Everyone loves Brian's artwork both temporarily on our window displays and permanently throughout our restaurant. He's been bringing our visions to life for over three years at both our previous and current locations."

Cordero, who plans to open a new location in northern Dutchess County, added: "Brian is an awesome artist with amazing talent. He understands the themes we look

to execute and pulls them off each and every time. He works incredibly fast, and we'll continue to use him. In fact, we have some work for him in our new Rhinebeck location opening up this Spring!"

Anthony Hardisty, a licensed real estate salesperson with San's Realty in Beacon, is a project sponsor. Hardisty said, "We love the artwork that he does. It brings new life to the Village. He is extremely talented, and we will be hiring him again." He continued, "When we had him do our windows, we had amazing feedback from people."

"I'm humbled. Very humbled," Palisi said about being named the 2023 Grand Marshal of the parade. "I don't work for recognition."

State Senator Rob Rolison said this is "a serious issue." He also noted that he was glad the Castle Point facility was not closing.

U.S. Army veteran Vicki Jackson said she has a history of service in her family. Her father served. Her brother, who was in the Army, served in Afghanistan. Jackson's husband served in Iraq, she said.

Jackson said she "truly appreciates the effort" being put in. She told of her brother, Timothy Harding, having an unknown blood disorder. When she told him about the benefits, Jackson said her brother did not know he was eligible.

According to a press release from the White House, which was released when the law was passed, it is "Named in honor of Sergeant First Class Heath Robinson, a decorated combat medic who died from a rare form of lung cancer, this historic legislation will help deliver more timely benefits and services to more than 5 million veterans—across all generations—who

may have been impacted by toxic exposures while serving our country. According to the White House,

- The PACT Act codifies VA's new process for evaluating and determining presumption of exposure and service connection for various chronic conditions when the evidence of a military environmental exposure and the associated health risks are strong in the aggregate but hard to prove on an individual basis. PACT requires VA to seek independent evaluation of this process as well as external input on the conditions it will review using this framework.

- The legislation removes the need for certain veterans and their survivors to prove service connection if they are diagnosed with one of 23 specific conditions.

- The PACT Act requires VA to conduct new studies of veterans who served in Southwest Asia during the Gulf War and analyses of post-9/11 veterans' health trends.

Jackson said the PACT Act lets veterans know "they're being seen, and they're being heard." She added: "Now we're doing what we can to give them the treatment that they need."

Climate Action group delves into the 'nuts and bolts' of data collection

Editor's note: This is the second in a series of articles to inform readers about Dutchess County's Climate Action Planning Institute (CAPI), an innovative 16-month program to identify and address ways for local governments to become more sustainable, involving County Government and selected towns and villages that were chosen to participate.

At their Feb. 15 meeting, participants in

Dutchess County's Climate Action Planning Initiative (Dutchess CAPI) took a "deep dive" into the intricacies of collecting data for the all-important first step of assessing their respective municipalities' greenhouse gas emissions.

Nine municipalities in Dutchess County are participating in the program, which aims to identify a path toward more sustainable local government operations. They include Dutchess County government; the cities of Beacon and Poughkeepsie; the towns of Amenia,

Pleasant Valley, Poughkeepsie and Rhinebeck; and the villages of Rhinebeck and Wappingers Falls.

Kale Roberts, senior program officer at International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) - USA, led most of the two-hour virtual meeting, which went into great detail about the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Inventory that will be an invaluable tool for the municipalities in their mission toward greater sustainability. The inventory includes emissions factors, emission

scopes, global warming potentials and data sectors (street lights and traffic signals; solid waste facilities; employee commute; buildings and facilities; vehicle fleet; water and wastewater facilities).

Not all municipalities will have all of these sectors (some may not have wastewater facilities, for example; and any facilities shared with other entities will not be included); but any relevant data will be entered first into data request templates and, later, to a cloud-based application called ClearPath.

DC 4-H shooting sports program grows and thrives

Teaching safety, responsibility and citizenship are core goals of the Dutchess County Long Rifles 4-H Club.

To become a New York State 4-H Certified Shooting Sports Instructor, over 15 hours of training is required, with a focus on youth development. On Saturday February 24, seven volunteer instructors and two junior instructors, attended the NYS 4-H Shooting Sports Winter Training in Ballston Spa to become certified in the following disciplines: Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun, Archery, and Hunting & Outdoor Skills.

The Dutchess CAPI members are liaising with department heads in their municipalities to gather and input data from 2019, which will serve as the baseline.

"For this inventory, the year 2019 was

chosen in order to provide an accurate portrayal of emissions in a full year prior to the pandemic," said CAPI Coordinator Mary Lambert of the Hudson Valley Regional Council (HVRC), which is administering the program. "By all choosing the same baseline year, we can

also more meaningfully compare results across the cohort."

Vanessa Bertozzi, the CAPI representative for the Village of Rhinebeck, noted the scope of this effort.

"In a meeting like this, my brain is in real-time trying to figure out the process for getting the data from the various sources," she said. "I'm trying to take the presentation and apply it to what I know about our village's staff, time resources, and the assets we oversee. I'm taking in the standard instructions and trying to figure out where I'll need to customize."

Bertozzi, who is in charge of making the data requests, said the Village of Rhinebeck has already gathered much of the data.

"Our water/wastewater clerk Chrissy Denu is a wiz when it comes to tracking our bills and invoices," Bertozzi said, "so she already has spreadsheet of data for each of electricity accounts, as well as spreadsheets of tracking on how much fuel oil, propane, diesel and gasoline the village purchases. We luckily already had a fleet inventory from some previous work in 2019. I submitted requests to our Water, Highway, and Wastewater department heads and they've already gotten back to me. I'm still working on gathering commute information."

Bertozzi said Michael Forlenza, a volunteer from the Village's Climate Smart Task Force, is taking the spreadsheets and other data and inputting it into the ClearPath tool.

"We hope to have all the data by [CAPI's] next meeting on March 15," she said. "We are aiming to be very comprehensive, so every department has data to share. ... Gathering data on everyone's commute is the most challenging, because we don't currently track this."

Devin Rigolino, Dutchess County's CAPI member, works in the Department of Planning & Development. He said the county's team "knew early on that the data gathering process for the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) inventory was going to be quite involved, simply because of the size

and complexity of County operations. Hearing additional details shared at our last meeting has reinforced our understanding of this phase of the project."

He added, "These details also further highlighted the value of a GHG inventory, and our team is feeling enthusiastic and prepared for the work ahead. We anticipate the data gathering portion of the overall CAPI project to take us into the summer of this year."

Rigolino said the Department of Planning & Development will have primary oversight of the CAPI project, although "identifying and consolidating these data for the inventory will involve several other County departments, including the Department of Public Works, Division of Solid Waste Management, and the Office of Central & Information Services.

"There will be several different sources for data that we will have to consider," he noted, "so working with the County's various databases and records will require close coordination with our colleagues in areas such as the Highway Garage and Auto Center, which maintains the County's heavy equipment and vehicle fleet, and our Building Division, which is responsible for the operation and maintenance of approximately 1.2 million square feet of occupied space."

CAPI is a project of the Hudson Valley Regional Council, an organization of county governments that provides a regional perspective, offers education and outreach, technical assistance, and advocacy to the communities it serves. The initiative is funded by the NYS DEC Climate Smart Communities Grant Program.

The team got homework in preparation for their next meeting on March 15:

- Help data resource identify key contacts for emissions data requests.

- Review the shared resources on the CAPI web site, including ICLEI's GHG inventory report template.

- Research and review other reports and the CSC (Climate Smart Communities) portal.

- Document and publicize the CAPI project.

In addition to the leads for each municipality, participants have a person who will help tell what Roberts calls "the climate story," advising them to "Start with people, stay with people."

"It's easy to get bogged down in the data discussion, when this is actually a very people-centered process," he said.

The assessment phase is just the beginning of the climate story.



Capturing the local history of today!

DCHS encourages connections in 'Poughkeepsie Q&A' pilot program

Editor's note: Writers with the Dutchess County Historical Society contribute articles twice a month to the Southern Dutchess News. This article details Poughkeepsie Q&A' pilot program.

The first eight in-depth oral histories recently collected from City of Poughkeepsie residents as part of the new "Poughkeepsie Q&A program" have just been published by the Dutchess County Historical Society on its website (dchsn.org).

The purpose of the program, also known as "PQ&A," is to provide a platform for residents - especially from groups who have been under-represented in the telling of the city's history - to introduce themselves and provide a personal perspective on the spectrum of life in Poughkeepsie.

Importantly, the text of each history is published in English and Spanish to help make the material widely accessible to the public. Poughkeepsie Q&A also celebrates the city's young talent. The program commissioned various city youth to take photo portraits of the oral history tellers, which are featured on the program's website.

Participants in Poughkeepsie Q&A include longtime residents of the city from varied walks of life, ranging from individuals born and raised in Poughkeepsie to those who have transplanted from elsewhere. They are single people and parents, and of various ages and livelihoods, including a maintenance director, educators, small business owners, and a retired police officer. Their comments range across a wide variety of experiences, perspectives

and topics.

"I can say to people I'm a product of the City of Poughkeepsie," points out Isis Benitez, a community outreach worker for YWCA Ulster County. "Sure, a lot has to do with my upbringing. But I went to school here and now I'm successful. I'm happy at a full-time job."

"I was encouraged to do the right things and I had mentors within my church, within the community," recounts Dwayne Douglas, from the Marist College Liberty Partnerships program. "For me, those guys were like heroes and were great examples. They lived in Poughkeepsie, they owned homes. If they didn't have college degrees, they were at their jobs for 15, 20, 25 years. Some would come to church from an overnight, exhausted but still showed up."

According to Jeffrey Kosmacher, editor of Poughkeepsie Q&A, participants provide invaluable insights on their character, that of their family and of their city. They also pull no punches. "What these generous and honest people share in their oral histories provides a special opportunity for residents of Dutchess County to connect with fellow community members," said Kosmacher, a longtime city resident.

"I happen to be one of the only people where I teach, and one of the few in the Poughkeepsie City School District, who has a doctorate, and that was before I was 42," points out lifelong resident Shanna Didymus. "Therefore, my mother having her children at a young age was not a negative precursor of how successful we would be in the future. Actually, it was part of our motivation to pursue success."

Michael Bennett moved to Poughkeepsie with his family when he

was 10, and recently retired from its police force. "There are a lot of multi-generational families here. They know who you are. They know whether you came from here or from somewhere else. The city has a memory. It's not a town of secrets," observes Bennett in his interview. "And when someone's doing well in their life and they're achieving, everybody's going to hear about that. I think people definitely feel a part of that. People here feel like a win for you is kind of a win for everybody."

Born and raised in Poughkeepsie, Ykim Anderson is a youth violence prevention worker at Family Services, and he reflects frankly on his own childhood. "When I was growing up, a lot of my family was still alive and living here, and we leaned on each other. You have to lean on that support system, the people who have your best interest in mind." Further, Anderson explains, "I was fortunate to always have a father in my life. He is the best man I know. And I still made mistakes growing up. So imagine what it's like for a lot of young black men who don't have that."

The insights provided in PQ&A interviews play an important role in the context of Dutchess County's emerging demographics. According to the 2020 U.S. Census, Poughkeepsie is now a "majority minority" city where people of color comprise 59 percent of the population, compared to 30 percent of Dutchess County residents. The census also reports that while 20 percent of city residents live below the poverty line,

only 8.6 percent of county residents do.

"Such differences make Poughkeepsians and Poughkeepsie and prey to harsh stereotyping in our area - when in reality there is much for all of us to learn from these individuals, and about the ups and downs of life in this city, as our society seeks insights and solutions for all sorts of matters. Oral history takes this learning to a much deeper level, hopefully even to prevent and overcome biased thinking," points out Kosmacher.

Consider related thoughts from participant Flo Duncan, who has lived in Poughkeepsie City since 1988 and raised a family with her husband. "My grandfather told me years ago that living in a city of any type, you make it your place. It's not somebody else making it your city. I never understood what he meant until I got older. I think that anybody who lives here would not judge us for stuff the way other people do who don't live here."

Poughkeepsie Q&A is supported by the Dutchess County Community Grants Fund of the Community Foundations of the Hudson Valley, and a partnership with The Art Effect educational nonprofit.




